Maranatha High School, located at 169 S. St. John Ave. in Pasadena, is a non-denominational Christian high school for young men and women in grades 9-12.

With the move to its new campus in September, approximately 565 students are enjoying their spacious 13 acre campus, which includes a collegiate gymnasium, an indoor Olympic-size swimming pool, a state of the art athletic field and a newly renovated Academic Center. The center houses 30 new classrooms including new science, biology, chemistry and physics labs as well as a state-of-the-art photography and

Mac lab.

Maranatha is a comprehensive college preparatory high school that seeks to train Christian students to positively impact the world. At Maranatha students are challenged to think critically, to gain competency in the academic disciplines, to demonstrate Christ-like compassion and involvement in the community and to build a strong Christian character.

Maranatha offers Advanced Placement courses in history, government, science, English, math, music, psychology, art and Spanish. The school's drama department recently performed "It's a

Wonderful Life" on the stage of the world renowned Ambassador Auditorium and is working on its spring production, "Oklahoma."

Maranatha also has 17 different sports programs including a new equestrian team and 15 different student clubs exist on campus (including, among others, a Habitat for Humanity club as well as an Adventure Club where students recently hiked, kayaked and swam with seals on Santa Barbara Island).
